Ask: This story reminds us that when God is on our side, we can be brave and courageous. Talk about how we can be brave and courageous for Jesus.

Key Phrase: Jesus is the Saviour

Today we looked at the story when Moses is in the desert, and the Israelites were complaining. God sent snakes into the desert and only when the Israelites looked to a bronze snake on a pole were they healed. This is used to remind us to look to Jesus.

Ask: This story reminds us to look to God. What does Jesus dying on the cross mean for us?

Key Phrase: God hears us when we cry out to him

Today we looked at the story when a brave man called Ehud saves the Israelites from the cruel hand of King Eglon.

Ask: This story reminds us God hears us when we cry out to him. Is there anything you would like God's help with? Ask God now for help.

Key Phrase: If God is for us who can be against us?

Today we looked at the story of when Deborah and Barak went out together into battle to defeat their enemy, knowing that God is on their side.

Ask: This story reminds us that God is on our side. Thank God together that he cares so much for us and will always help us and show his love for us.

Key Phrase: God gives us the strength to do the right thing even when it's hard

Today we looked at a story when God helps Jonathan, (David's friend), stay loyal and be a good friend, even when it was hard.

Ask: This story reminds us that God gives us strength to do the right thing even when it's hard. Ask God to help you this week in everything you are going to do.
