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In 1995, Deb and I arrived at King's to a faithful church of just under 200 people. We could never have imagined what God would do: lives have been transformed, leaders raised up and sent, and buildings bought and renovated. Now around 2000 of us gather across four sites. God has been so faithful to King's.

It has been a huge privilege to lead King's over the last 30 years. I am now preparing to hand over to Joe Macnamara who becomes our Lead Pastor in September 2025.

We believe this is more than a leadership transition—it's a chance to build for generations to come.



Years ago, we were given a prophetic picture: "King's is like Niagara Falls, strong and secure. You do not need to worry about King's... ..but I am calling you to be like Victoria Falls, a church whose reach goes further, a wider calling."

We also had a key prophetic poem that inspired us to believe God for great things:

It's not just growth or buildings
money and the cost,
It's Catford, London UK too,
to reach the millions lost"***

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The Invitation.

As we step into this new chapter, we're inviting everyone at King's to participate in this next stage of Vision 2030 by investing in our future together.

We have an opportunity to give with faith and generosity to build for the generations to come. Together, let's continue to reach, restore and resource.



Our Faith Target.

We believe we're called to build a church that can serve thousands of people and bless hundreds of churches. To lay a foundation for the future, we are setting an ambitious **faith target for the next 3 years**. From September 2025 we are believing to raise at least:

- **£3.1 million in Sept 2025 – Aug 2026**
- **£3.2 million in Sept 2026 – Aug 2027**
- **£3.3 million in Sept 2027 – Aug 2028**

This is the equivalent of **at least an additional £500,000 to be given each year** on top of our existing giving, which is an additional £1.5 million over the next 3 years.

This will enable us to:

- **Save £295,000 in interest** by clearing the final £950,000 of our building debt.
- **Refurbish the toilets** at both our Lee and Downham sites.
- Improve our hire **venue for Beckenham**.
- Expand our next generation team and invest in **staffing capacity**.
- Increase our support for **Newfrontiers**.

How can I play my part?

Between now and our Gift & Pledge Days in October, we're asking you to prayerfully consider two things. Firstly, how much you are able to pledge over the next 3 years, and secondly, what additional gift you could bring.

Please take the time to fill out your pledge form enclosed in the envelope, and come ready to hand it in, along with any gift you would like to bring. We would love to see a significant start towards investing in our future together.

FAQs

1.

I am already giving regularly. Should I still make a pledge?

Yes. This is an opportunity to review your existing giving and pledge to give an additional amount over the next 3 years.

2.

Where should my pledge giving go?

In order to reach our faith target of £3.1m, £3.2m and £3.3m over the next 3 years, you can either start to give or increase your existing giving to King's and/or Vision 2030.

3.

Will any pastoral staff know what I am giving?

It is our intention for none of the pastoral staff to know what you give. Our finance staff team are solely responsible for counting, processing gifts and keeping records.

What if my financial situation changes?

We understand that circumstances can change, whether for better or worse. Therefore, you can adjust your giving at any time.

5.

How often will we have Gift Days over the next 3 years?

We'll continue to take a weekly offering at our Sunday services. In addition, we'll hold Gift Days each year in October and May, as moments for giving one-off gifts.

Can I get involved after the October Pledge Moment?

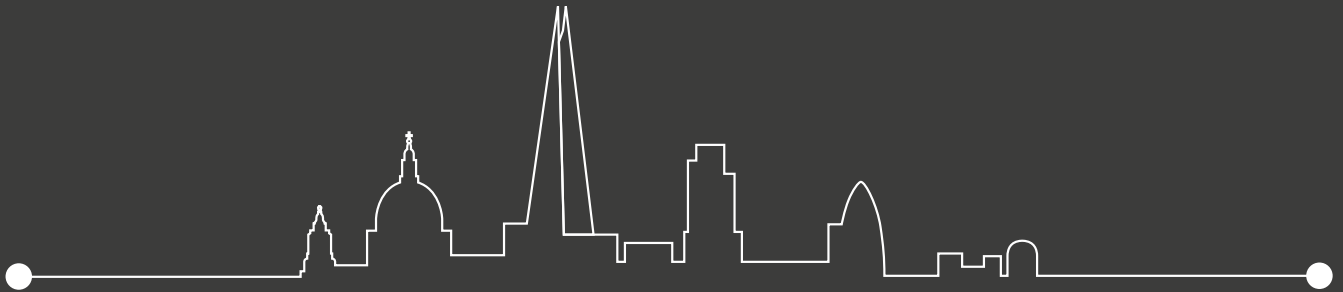
Yes. The October 2025 Gift & Pledge Days is the launch of 'Investing in our Future Together'. Anyone can step into giving at King's and play their part at any stage.
