Dear families,

As you know we really value our children and their spiritual growth. As we won't be meeting on Sundays, we have put together some short teaching videos that we can watch with our children and other activities we can do together as a family. These will be available each week at **kingschurchlondon.org/kids-at-home**.

Each week we will look at a different Bible story and give you activities you can do as a family midweek and on Sundays.

The emphasis is on us doing these activities with our children as, more than ever, we will feel that responsibility to share our faith with them. The activities are supposed to be fun, so don't pressure yourself. Do what you can and build on it each week.

These are the activities that will be available each week:

MIDWEEK

To watch – There will be a Bible story available for you to watch with your family.

To worship – There will be worship songs for you to sing along to with your children.

To make – We will also send you a craft activity idea. What you make will have a link to the story and we would encourage your child to have it with them on Sunday to use in the story.

SUNDAYS

It would be lovely to try and watch the Bible story, to pray and to play the game before the **Sunday morning online service**. Sometimes the game will be in the video; other times it will be something you can play as a family.

You will need 15-20 minutes for these activities.

To learn – On Sunday one of our fab 0-9s team will be teaching our children from the Bible story in a fun and interactive way. There will be a video for the 0-4s and one for the 5-9s.

To pray – We will give you ideas of things to pray for as a family.

To play – There will be an idea for a game to play with your children too!

We hope you enjoy using these activities and have lots of fun as a family learning more about Jesus. Here are this week's activities:
