To Make

Make a cross, using whatever you can get your hands on. Here are some ideas...

To Pray

'God loved the world SO much that He gave His only Son that whoever believes in Him will not die but have eternal life.' John 3v16

God sent Jesus because He loves us very much; He wants to be our special friend. Sometimes we do things that makes God sad so it's so important that we say sorry to God. The great thing about God is that He loves us all the time and always forgives us.



0-4s Draw a picture of things that make God sad and things that make God happy. Ask God to help you to do the things that make Him happy

King's Kids Write or draw things that we do sometimes that make God sad. Put a bin or small bowl in the middle of your group. Ask everyone to go round one at a time and either say out loud what you are sorry for, or just say it quietly and then throw the paper into the bin/bowl. The great thing is when we say sorry to God He forgives us. He says that's okay and gives us a big hug. That's called forgiveness. That's why Jesus dying on the cross was so important. He made a way so we can be close to God and be forgiven.
