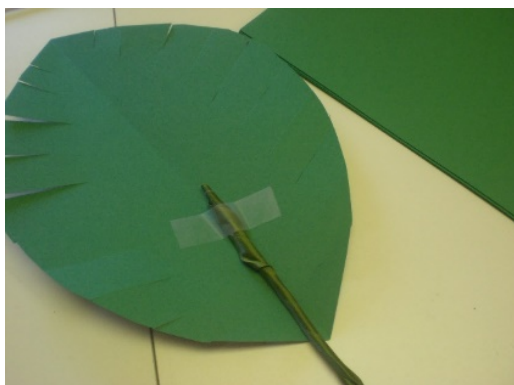


To Make

The children can use these on Sunday in the story.

Resources: paper – green or white, green colouring pens, hands

Draw round hands on green paper or use white paper/ card and colour it in green. Then roll up a sheet of paper and make into a tube. Then stick the hands onto the tube.



Or make a large leaf shape and kids can decorate as they like.

Sunday Activities

To Pray

Go round and say something you really like about Jesus.

Remind the children Jesus is King of Kings yet is our gentle, kind and loving friend and that he cares about what we care about.

Ask the children to share anything they are worried about and want to pray about. It would be good to pray about this same thing each day and next Sunday ask the children if they feel any different. How did they feel God answered their prayer?

To Play

Shout out 'Donkey' – All children make donkey sounds and walk around on all fours.

Shout out 'Jesus' – All children make a crown with their hands and shout 'Jesus is King'.

Shout out 'Lay down your coat' – All children lie on the floor as still as they can!

Jesus is coming – All children wave their hands like they are waving palm branches.

Celebrate – All children jump up and down and shout 'Jesus is King'.

Activity sheet

If you have a printer and would like an activity sheet for your child to do during the service today you can print the one below.

Here are some other ideas:

- Draw a donkey for them to colour in.
- Or ask them to draw a picture from the story. If you have a children's Bible you can let them look in that for ideas. A suggestion would be to draw Jesus riding on the donkey and all the people waving the leaves from the trees.
- Older children may want to make their own comic strip.
