To Pray

As our memory verse says, God loves it when we give happily. This doesn't have to be our money. How generous we are depends on our heart.

Talk about things we can do to be generous. It will vary depending on the age of your children. As a family pray and ask God to show you how you can be more generous. Ask Him to help you have a heart that is generous.



Maybe share some ideas together and write or draw them down. Stick them up on a wall to remind you some of the things that you have thought about. Ask God to keep prompting you to be generous each day. It would be good to encourage the children and share times you have seen them be really generous.

To Play

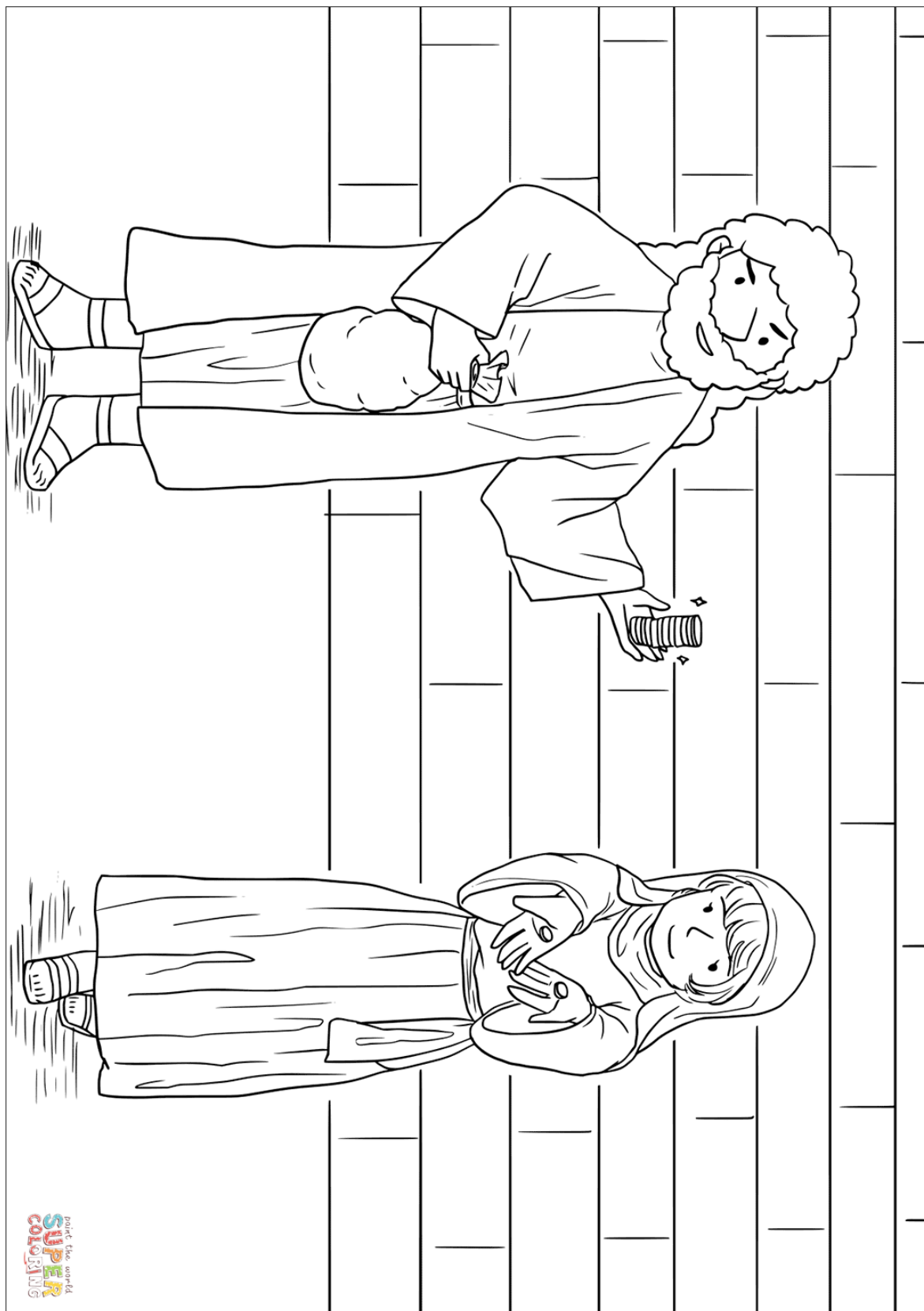

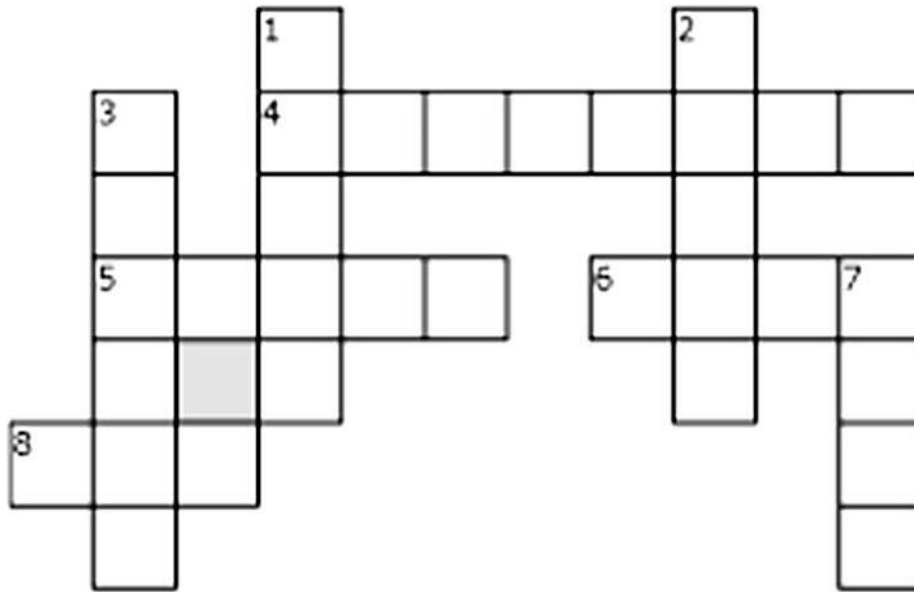
