To Pray

We would love you to pray with your children. We hope this simple activity will help you as you do this.

Can you think of a situation where you need to be reminded that Jesus is King? Maybe you are worried about something, or that there is someone you know that is unwell.

After thinking about the situation, you can ask to know Jesus' peace and calm.

As Denise mentions in the video, you could listen to the song My Lighthouse which is full of truth – youtu.be/JeJvKkBV6rY – and draw yourself standing by calm water looking up to the lighthouse, which represents Jesus. You might want to write 'Jesus is King' on the picture.

Don't forget to fill in your crown. If you haven't made one, you can make a crown using paper or an old cereal packet and decorate anyway you would like – each week why not add what you learned about Jesus to this crown? This will help you remember Jesus is King.

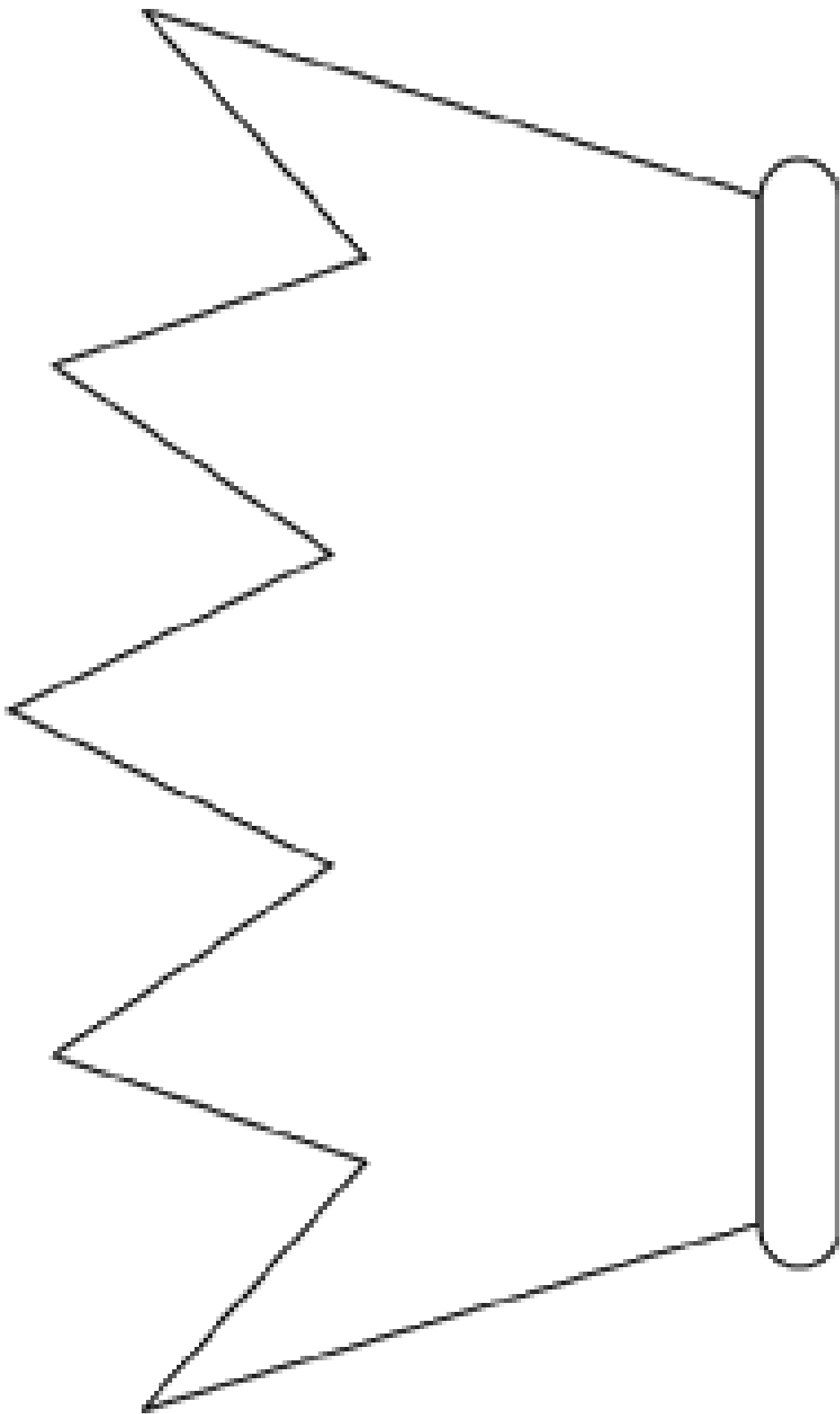
