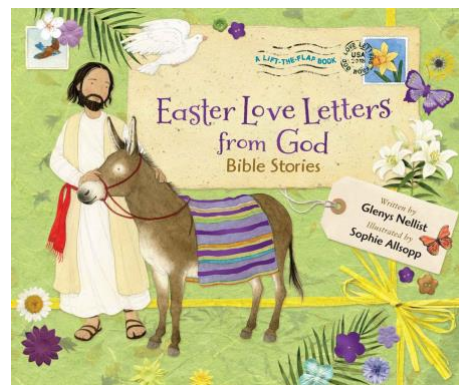

## To Pray

Here is a letter taken from **Easter Love Letters from God** by Glenys Nellist.

*Dear Kids at home*

Why not ask your children if they want to know God more? Give them a moment to say that either out loud or in their heart. After they have done this, you might want to get them to write Jesus a letter or draw a picture thanking Him for His love.

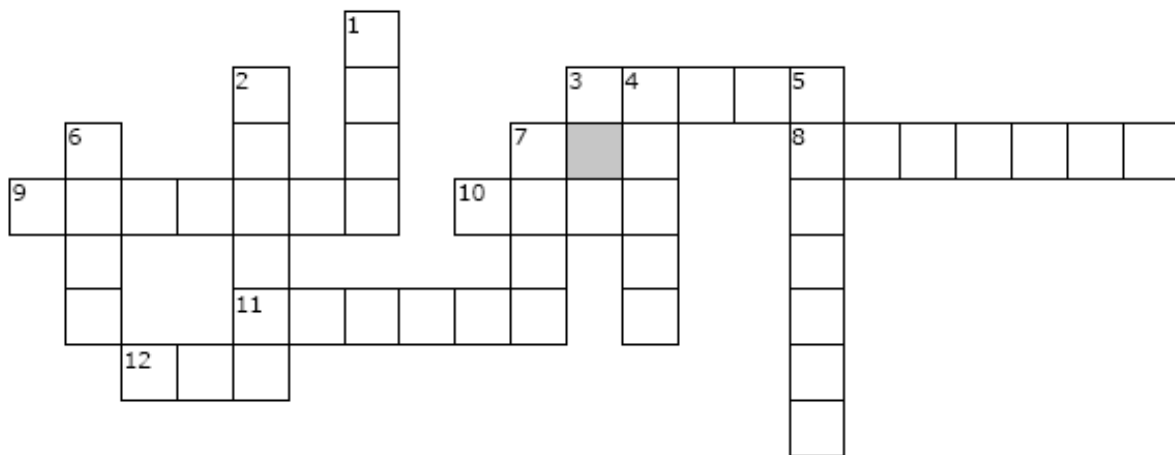
