To Pray

God keeps His promises ... and He never breaks them.

God had promised to set the people free and finally they were free. It had been years and years. Sometimes we have to wait a long time to see God answer a prayer or for one of His promises to come true, but remember **God keeps His promises ... and He never breaks them.**



Is there something you would like to pray for that you haven't seen an answer to? Why not share what that is and pray for it together? The children may want to write or draw their prayer.

Ask God to give you the strength to keep trying when things become difficult and you want to give up. Remind the children that **Whatever is going on ... God is always there** – just like he was with the Israelites.
