To Pray

Remind the children that God never breaks His promises to us.

He promised Jacob that he would treat him kindly (Genesis 32 v 12).

God is kind to us. Remind the children of the memory verse.

God is good to us and wants good things for us.

Remind the children that God is always kind and will always care for us.

Go round and share how we know God is kind to us or think of times in the Bible where we have seen God be kind, just like we saw in today's story when Jacob and Esau met.



Activities
