Colouring sheet – If you have a printer there is a colouring sheet on the next page that you can print off and colour in.



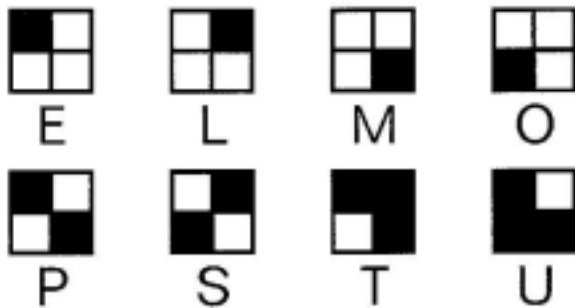


Other ideas for older children – Use the code to find out the name of the baby who was found in the basket and what his name means, then complete the wordsearch.
