You could pray for those you know who are treated unfairly because they look different (this may be the children themselves) and pray that each of us will show God's love to those around you.



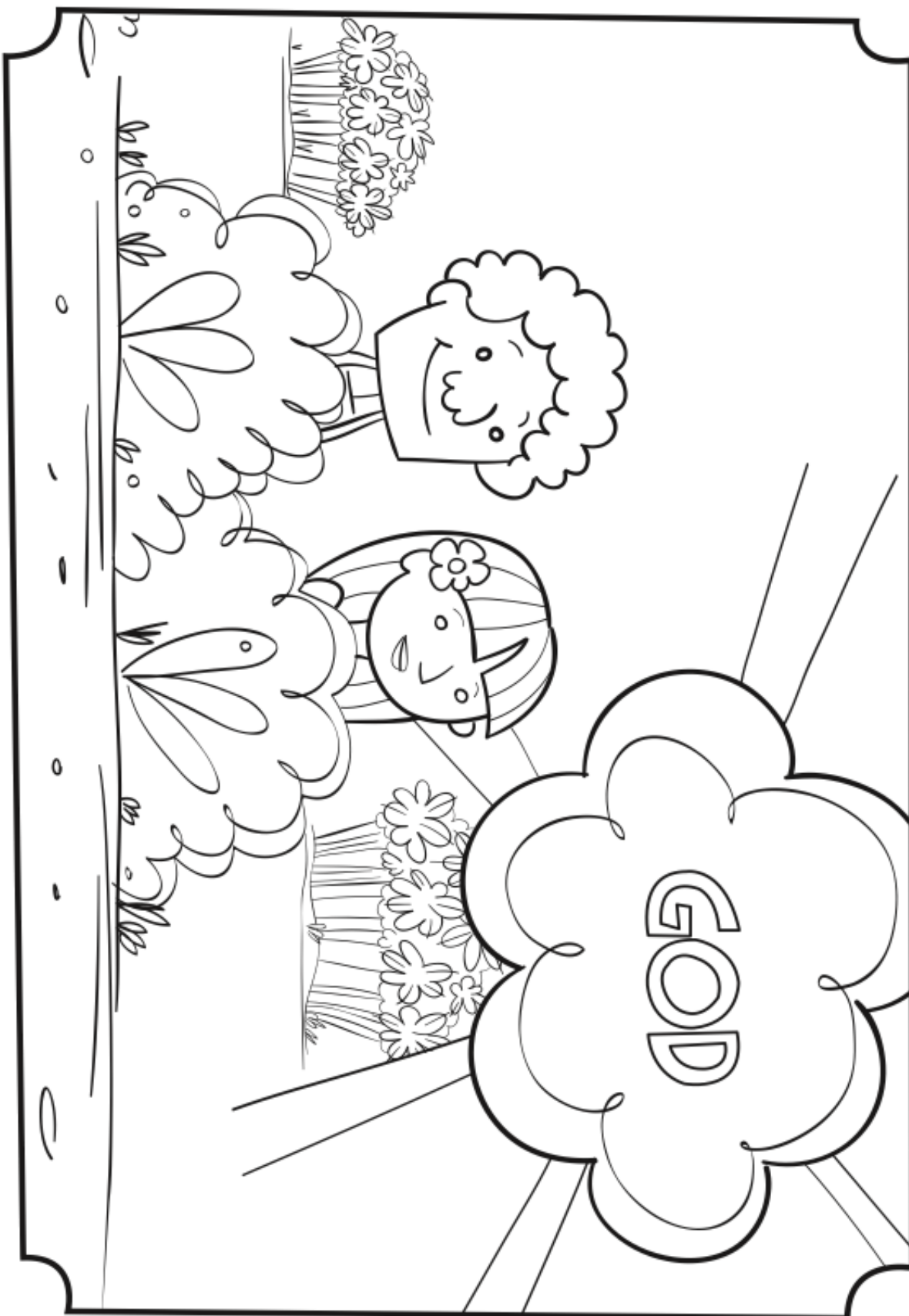
Activities

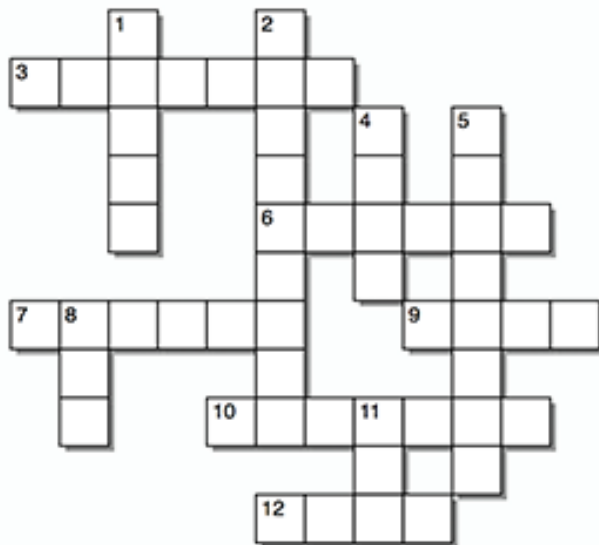
