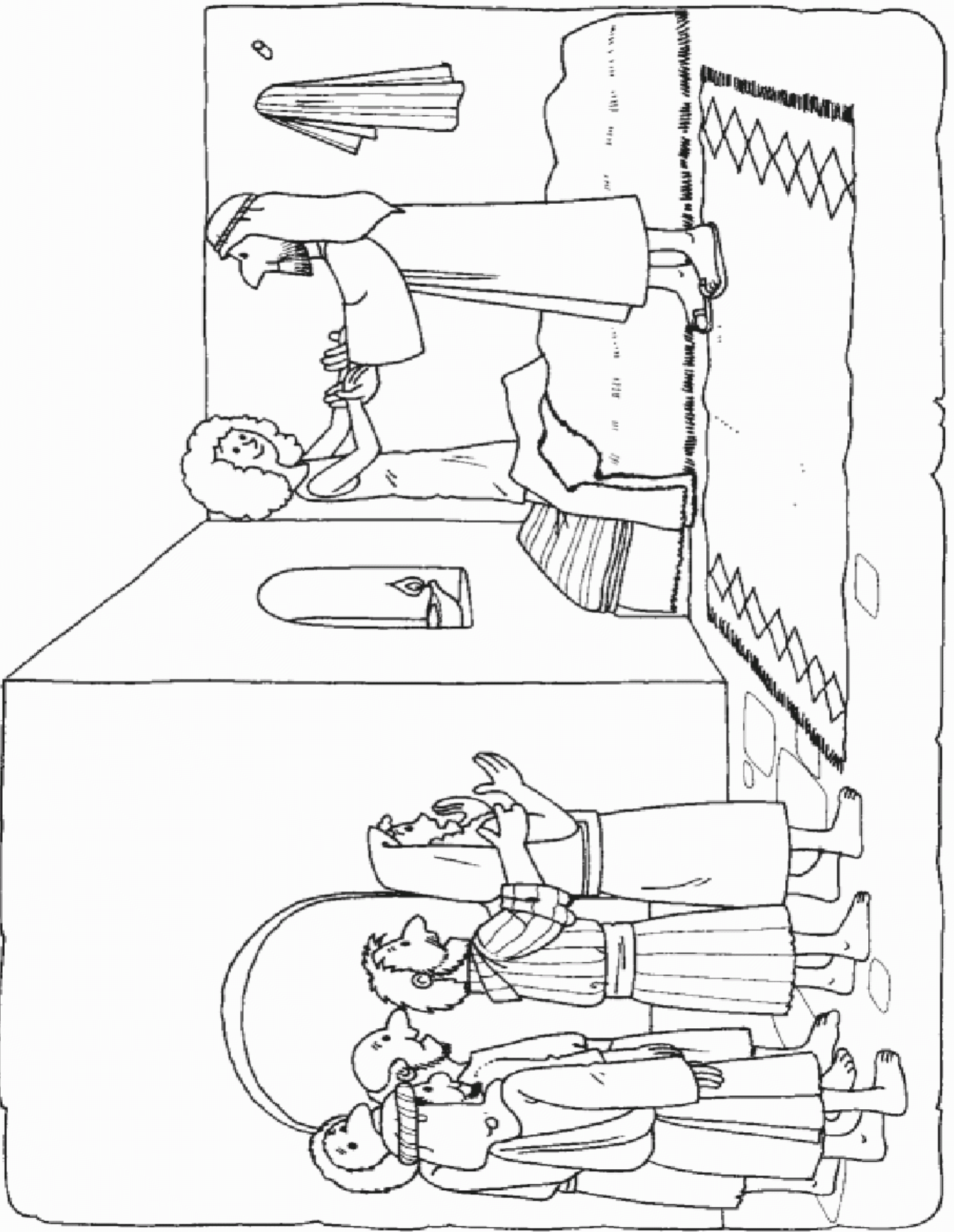

Colouring sheet – If you have a printer there is a colouring sheet you can print off and colour in.

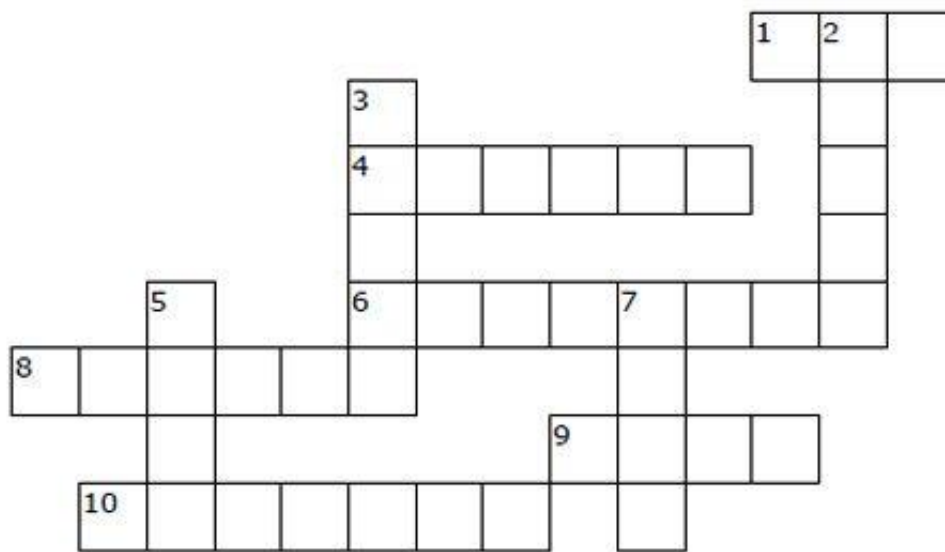




Jesus Raises a Dead Girl
