Memory verse

To Pray

Sometimes we can feel frightened or worried about things, like Peter who felt brave at first and then he got scared.

Is there anything that worries us at the moment or makes us feel scared?

Share together and then draw a picture of the scene from the story of Jesus walking on the water on one side, and the boat on the other. In the middle draw a picture of you holding Jesus' hand (you could do this as a quick sketch or spend a longer time as a family making a really lovely collage using foil, etc. to make the sea and draw pictures of all of you holding Jesus' hand).

Remember that when we are scared we just need to remember to ask Jesus to hold our hand and let us know that He is with us and just like Peter we will then begin to feel safe again. Go round and pray for each other, asking God to help you remember you are never alone. It would be good to go over the memory verse again.

To Play

Play sleeping sea lions. Everyone pretends to be asleep like Jesus was. Go round making noise, jokes, funny faces and try and try to wake up the sleeping sea lions. Whoever stays asleep the longest wins.

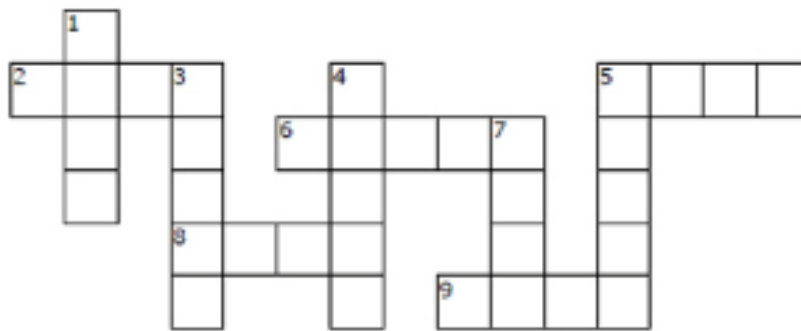
