Remind the children that God always listens to our prayers.

Why not everyone pray at the same time and say the prayer into their hands and when the prayer has finished hold it tight in their hands on their heart and then throw it high into the air. All together shout A.....MEN!



To Play

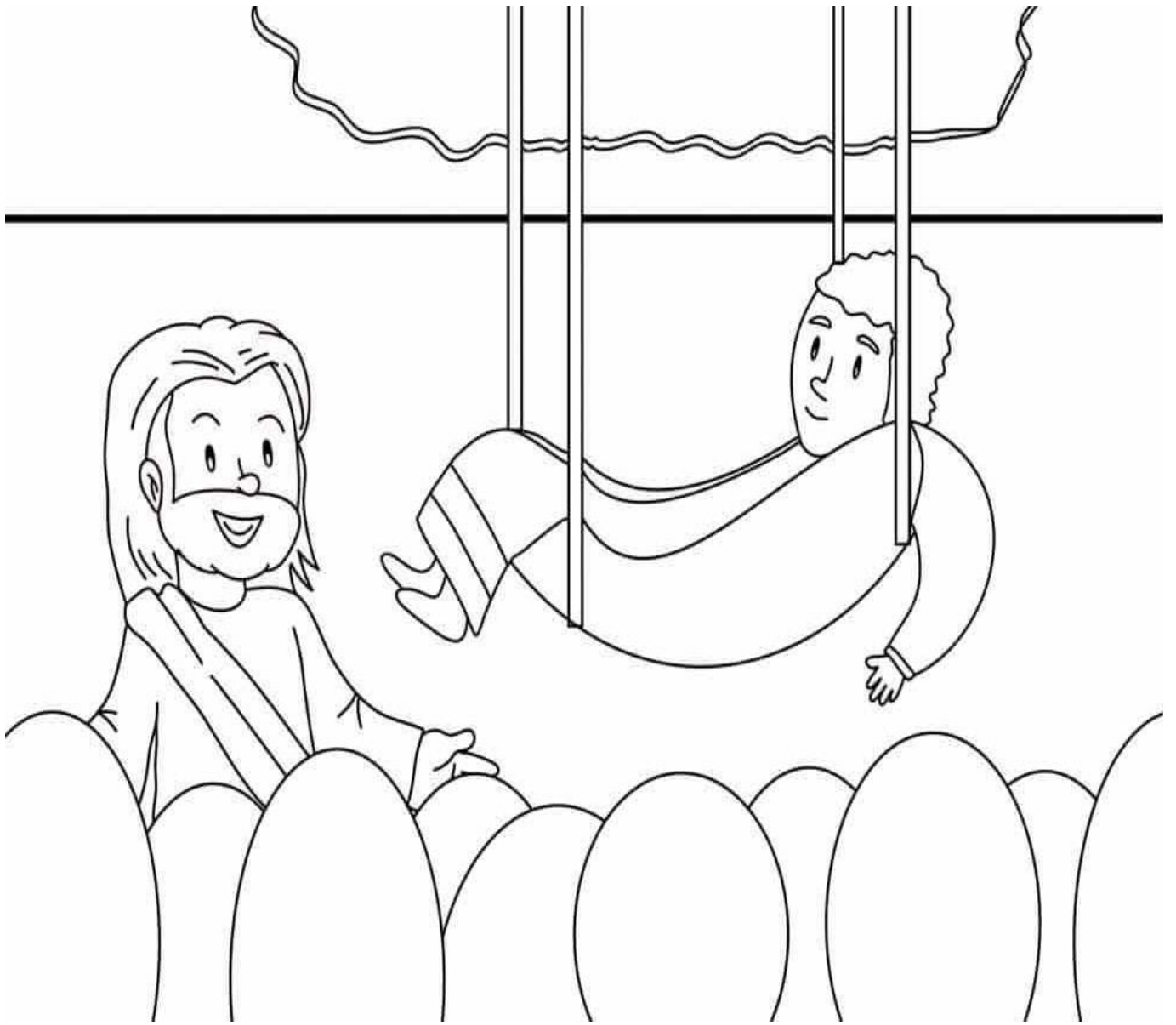
Play charades. Choose some of the healing stories of Jesus and act them out and the kids have to guess what healing Jesus is doing.
