

# WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

This week we are looking at the Holy Spirit as God our helper. We try to explain the Holy Spirit so that the children understand who He is. We describe Him as God our helper.

## Adults

After this week's initial introduction to the Holy Spirit, we will start to look at *The Fruit of the Spirit*. We try to explain that when we invite the Holy Spirit (God our helper) to live in our heart, we begin to become more like God, showing, love, joy, peace, etc.



Today Kerri-Jane talks about inviting the Holy Spirit to come and live in us. This may not be something you have spoken about with your child before. If you want to chat about this with them, our advice would be to keep it simple, remind them that the Holy Spirit is God our helper, and if we want to be more like God, we can ask Him to help.

## To Pray

Why not start off by seeing if you can remember any of the Fruit of the Spirit. How many can they remember? Do they know what they all mean? Afterwards remind the children that in the Bible in John's gospel, the Holy Spirit is referred to as The Helper. Isn't it good that God sends His Helper! Why not thank God together that we have a Helper and if there is anything you need help with, why not ask for help.




## Learn About The Holy Spirit

### The Trinity

God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit are three persons who are all the same person – God. This is called the Trinity (Trinity means three).

When we think of God living inside us, in our hearts, and speaking to us each day, this is the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit lives inside every person who has become a Christian.

Work the puzzle to see a dove, a symbol of the Holy Spirit.



### The Holy Spirit in the Old Testament

Before Jesus came, the Holy Spirit did not live inside every person.

God sent the Holy Spirit into a person when he had a special job for the person to do.
