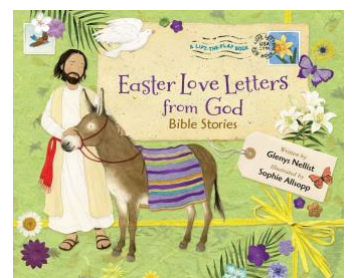
Retelling of the Bible story

To Pray

Today's story is the one that our Christian faith is built on. The love letter below is a letter inviting the children to give their lives to Jesus. Why not read it again as a family and share how you all feel knowing what Jesus did for us.

Obviously, the age of the children will affect the level of conversation you have. If you haven't already, you might want to talk to the children about Jesus being their forever friend. You can explain that when we say sorry we are forgiven for the things we do wrong. We can be close to Him forever because of what Jesus did on the cross and by coming alive.

OR

You may just want to talk about the story of Easter and how brilliant it is that God sent Jesus so we can know Him forever and choose something to thank God for.

Dear Kids at Home

Can you believe that my son, Jesus, came back to life? Only the King of the whole world could do that. Jesus is the King of Love, the King of Hope and the King of Heaven. And he wants to be the King of your life too. Will you let him? Just whisper ...

Jesus, I believe in you. Teach me more about how you want me to live. Thank you for showing me what love looks like. Thank you for dying on the cross and for coming back to life, for forgiving me, and showing me the way to heaven. Amen.

If you just whispered that prayer...welcome to my family! You are now part of the most wonderful family on earth, and it's wonderful because ... you just joined it.

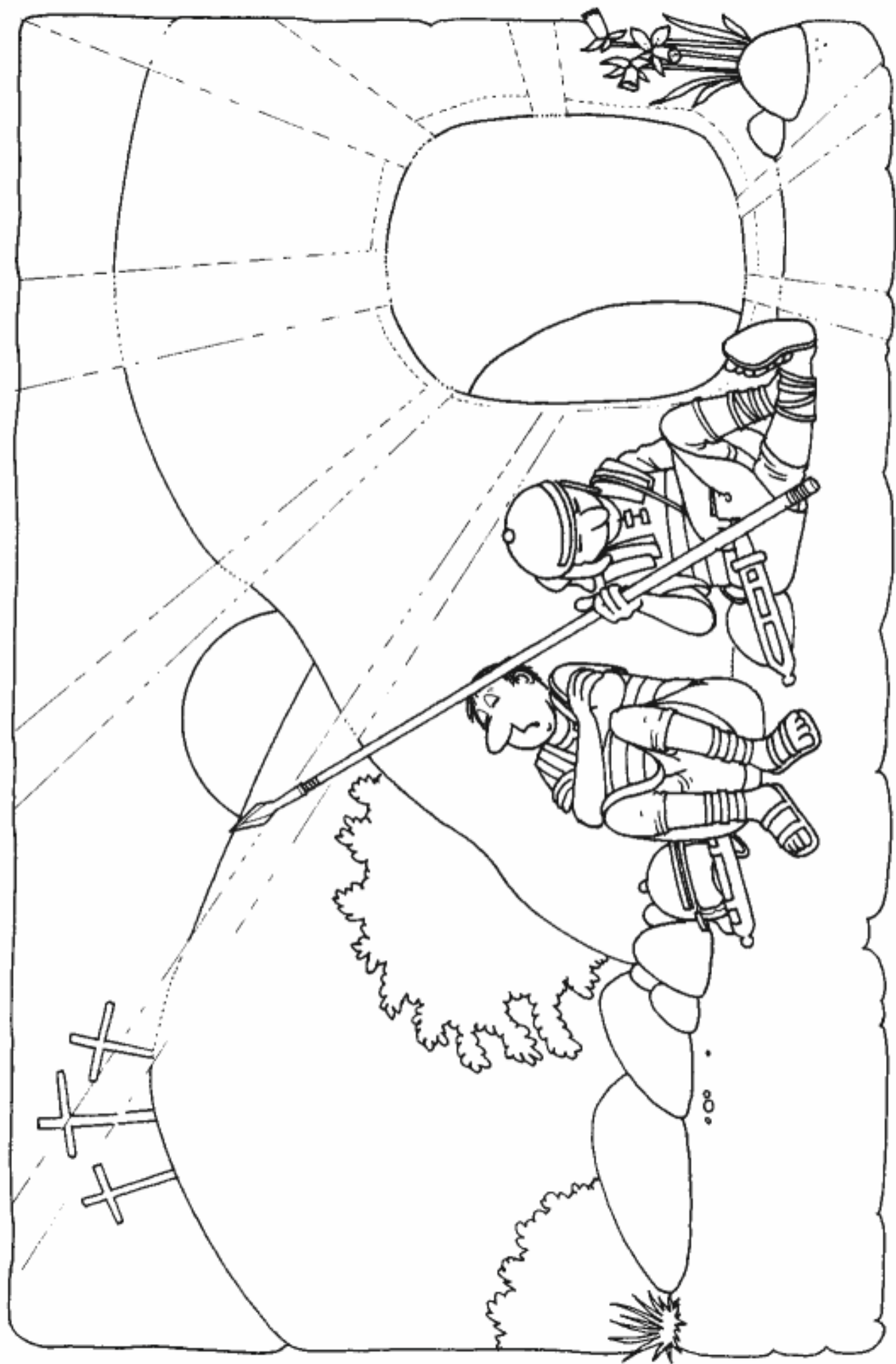

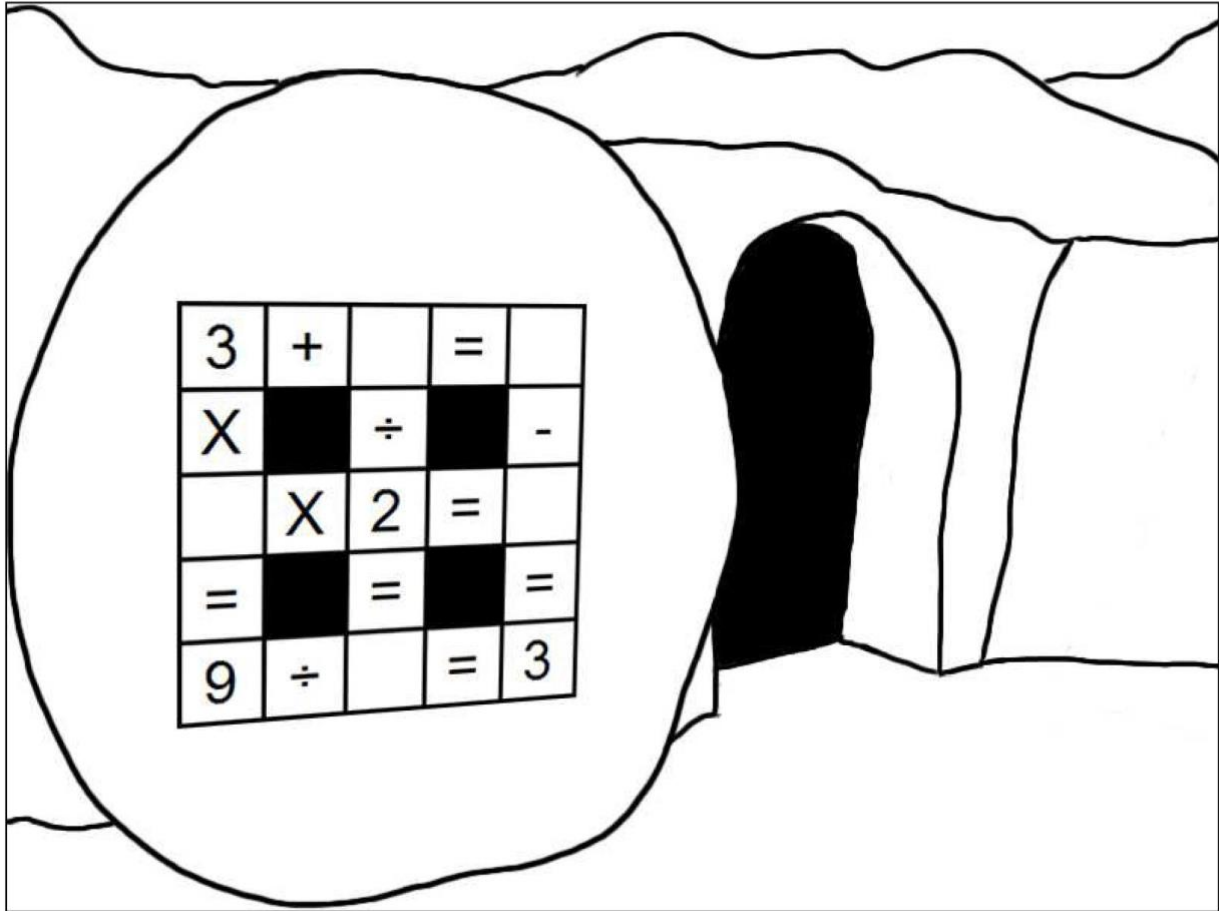
