Remind the children that God is always there for them and will never leave them. After listening to the songs, share with one another how you felt. End with a prayer thanking God for helping.



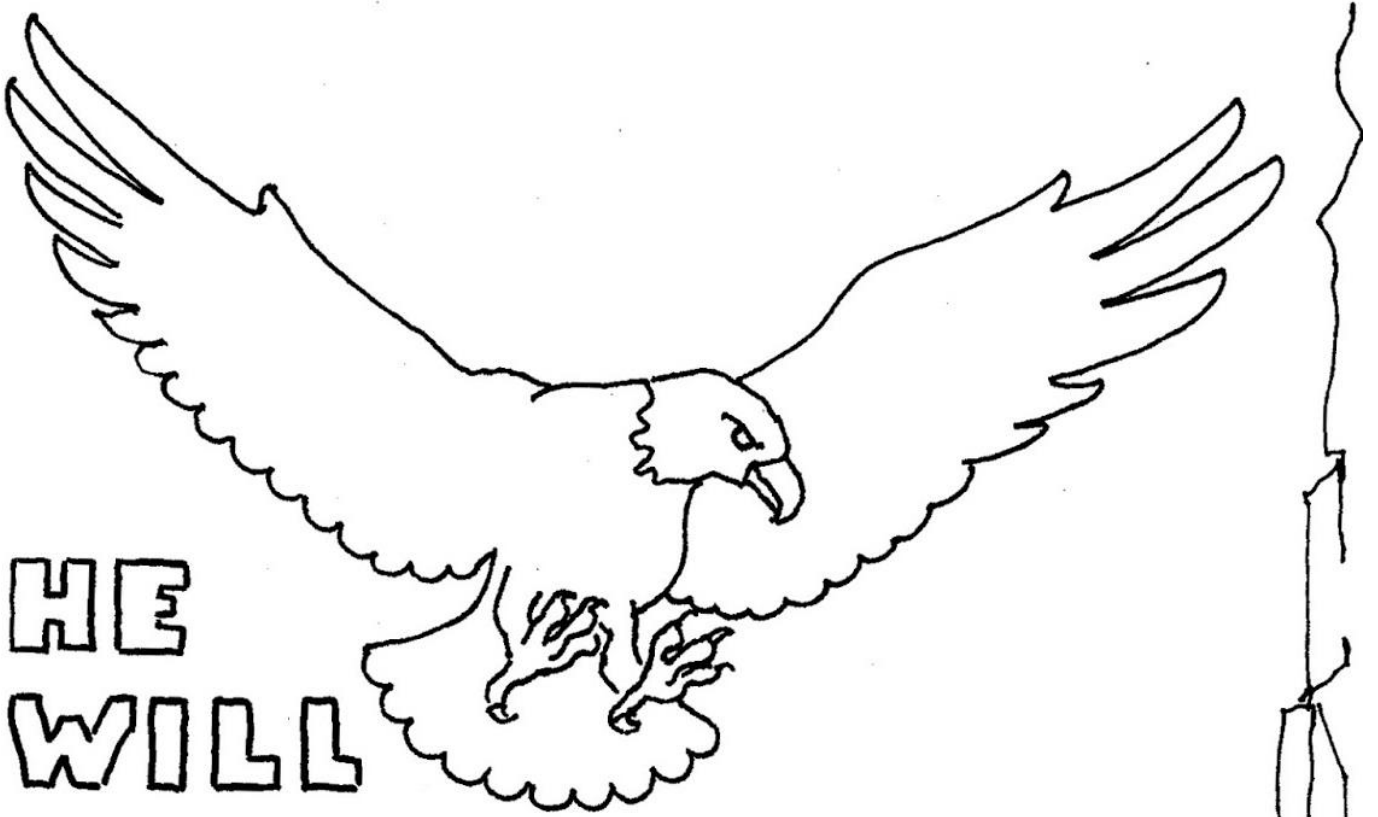
Changes over the summer
