To Pray

We would love you to pray with your children. We hope this simple activity will help you as you do this.

Why not spend some time thinking if there is anything that you would like to talk to Jesus about? Everything that you care about is of interest to Jesus, so you can talk to Him about anything. Have a think and then talk to Him about it.

You can do this in lots of ways:

- you can go for a walk and talk to Him,
- draw a picture of what you would like to share with Him,
- write it down or just say it now.

There are no rules about talking to Jesus. Just know that He is interested because He cares about you and always will.

Don't forget to fill in your crown. If you haven't made one, make a fun crown using paper or an old cereal packet and decorate anyway you would like – each week why not add what you learned about Jesus to this crown? This will help us remember **Jesus is King**.

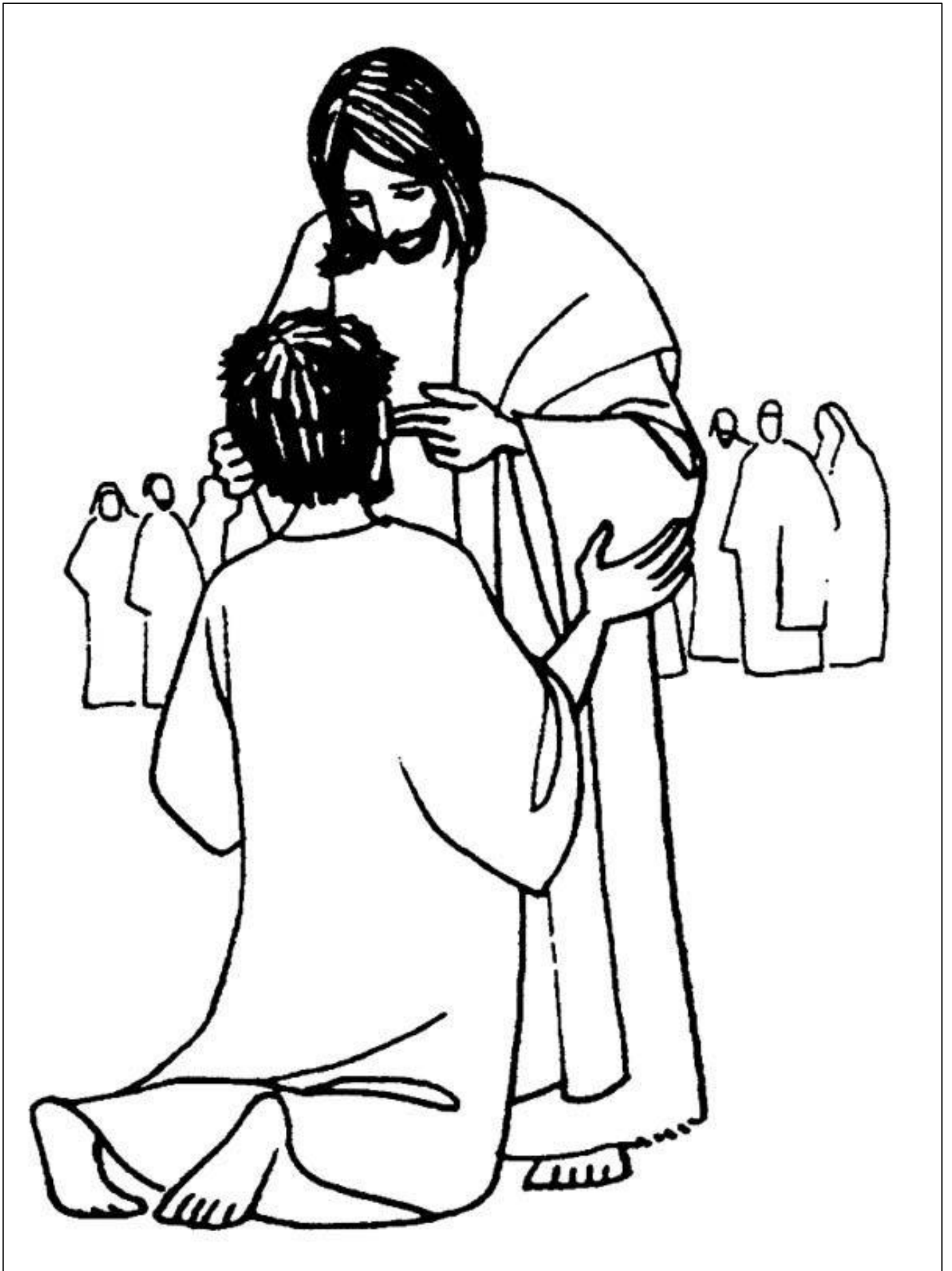
